

# Navigating a Slideshow

Use the following keys to navigate through the slideshow:

→	Next slide
←	Previous slide
END	Last slide
HOME	First slide
↑	Enlarge image
↓	Shrink and re-center image
H	Hide/Show Image
C	Hide/Show Control Panel
I	Display Catalog Data
Y	Split screen vertical
X	Split screen horizontally
U	Restore full display (remove the split)
ESC	Exit from ImageViewer

If you are in Vertical split, hold SHIFT and use a key to move the right screen only.

If you are in Horizontal split, hold SHIFT and use a key to move the bottom screen only.

In either split, hold CTRL and use a key to move both screens.

## Use the mouse to navigate

If you have a slideshow open and point to various parts of the screen, options to click on will appear.

		Shift + Click
+	Enlarge the image	Enlarge to Maximum Resolution
-	Shrink and re-center image	Fit to screen
◀	Previous slide	First slide
▶	Next slide	Last slide
⏮	Display the control panel	N/A

## Use the control panel to navigate

If you have a slideshow open in full view, you can open the control panel and use that to navigate through it. The row along the top is used for splitting and restoring the display as well as minimizing or closing ImageViewer. The middle row has the normal navigational buttons. The lowest row allows you to open a slideshow from your list.
